

Welcome to Class 4

Currently in Class 4 there are 11 pupils. The lessons follow the KS4 curriculum from Samuel Ward and are taught by the class teacher (Mrs South) and subject specialists. These are taught using a primary school model, where teachers will come over to us and pupils remain in the classroom. The class teacher from Churchill remains in the room throughout the day to support pupils and work alongside the specialist.

In the classroom, pupils may work together in small groups, in pairs or independently. They can also choose to sit at an individual work station. There are also two full time learning support assistants who help with our learning.

Each day, we begin by discussing the daily timetable and discussing the lessons we will be having. This gives pupils the opportunity to raise any concerns or ask questions.

Some pupils, who have individual timetables, integrate into lessons at Samuel Ward, for example Drama, Music, German and CRS. Some pupils also taking part in sporting enrichment sessions there.

Class 4 are also supported individually and in groups by Speech and Language Therapists, Occupational Therapists, the Educational Psychologist, the Family Liaison and the Pupil Support Coordinator. We strive to meet the individual needs of pupils both within lessons and through intervention programmes that develop literacy and numeracy skills and address social, speech, language and physical needs.
